ORDER

The above named complainant, a person with locomotor disability filed a complaint dated 04.10.2013 before the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities under the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995, hereinafter referred to as the 'Act', regarding implementation of Government of India's Circulars/Orders for promotion in respect of employees with disabilities working in Indian Railways.

2. The complainant had submitted that Government of India vide O.M. No.36035/7/95 Estt. Dated 18.02.1997 and 16.01.1998 had issued orders for promoting persons with disabilities in Group 'C' and 'D' posts similar to those of SC/ST employees, but the Railway Board has not yet issued any order/circular in this connection. He also submitted that Hon'ble High Court of Delhi had given orders favouring employees with disabilities working with Railways through a judgement dated 07.12.2007 in Writ Petition (C) Nos.11818 and 13627-28/2004. DoP&T introduced reservation in promotion for persons with disabilities vide Office Memorandum No.36035/8/89-Estt (SCT) dated 20.11.1989 within Group 'D', Group 'D' to Group 'C' and within Group 'C'.

- 2. Though the complainant had not filed specific complaint, however, vide this Court's letter dated 31.01.2014, the matter was taken up with the respondent for submission of his comments. When no reply was received despite reminders dated 04.12.2014 and 28.07.2015, the case was listed for personal hearing on 12.01.2017.
- 3. None of the parties appeard before this Court during the hearing on 12.01.2017, nor any intimation was received from them. Next date of hearing was fixed on 21.02.2017, but the parties failed to appear before the Court again.
- 4. In view of the above and in terms of Rule 42(4) of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Rules, 1996 the case was dismissed in default.
